Equipment and Target Assignment

No official equipment inspection before the qualification, judge/s will be conducting random checks on equipment

Arrows

All arrows must be marked with the archer's initials to be easily identified. The maximum arrow diameter allowed is $\frac{27}{64}$ " or 10.7mm.

Target Assignment

Target assignment for the first day of qualification will be put in a random order in the session assigned to at registration. Target assignment for Sunday will be based on the ranking after the first 60 arrows in descending order. The target assignment will be updated as soon as possible at the end of the sessions on Saturday.

Order of Shooting and Timing

Order of Shooting

There is a maximum of 4 archers per target, split into 2 details (AB-CD).

Saturday

Archer A and archer C will shoot on the left side while archer B and archer D will shoot on the right side.

For the 1st half of the qualification, archers AB will shoot first on the bottom targets. Archers CD will shoot second on the top targets.

For the 2nd half of the qualification, the shooting order and the target position will change. Archers CD will start with the bottom targets. Archers AB will shoot second on the top targets.

The shooting order will be announced and displayed on the timers.

Sunday

For the first 15 arrows of the qualifications, archers AB will shoot first on the bottom targets. Archers CD will shoot second on the top targets.

For the remaining 15 arrows of the qualifications, the shooting order and the target position will change. Archers CD will start with the bottom targets. Archers AB will shoot second on the top targets.

Timing

During qualification, archers will be given 90 seconds to shoot 3 arrows. In the event of a shoot – off, archers will be given 30 seconds for 1 arrow. Time and signals will be displayed on the timers.

Target Faces

Target faces

Archers are responsible to hang, change and remove their own target faces. Fresh target faces will be made available at the centre of the FOP.

Recurve Open, Compound Open (Men/ Women)

Archers competing in the Recurve Open (Men/ Women) and Compound Open (Men/ Women) will shoot the 3-spot triangular target face as shown below.

Scoring Format

Qualification

Scoring format

- Recurve: X10 – 10 – 10 (yellow), 8 – 7 (red), 6 (blue)
- Compound: X10 – 10 – 9 (yellow), 8 – 7 (red), 6 (blue)
- Barebow: X10 – 10 – 10 (yellow), 8 – 7 (red), 6 – 5 (blue), 4 – 3 (black), 2 – 1 (white), 0 (out of the outermost ring)

Ties and shoot – off

In the event of a tie for a place in the high stakes rounds and, in the finals, one (1) arrow closest to the centre will be decisive. For Recurve and Compound Open, archers may choose to shoot any spot of the target face. The judge will make the final call on the closest arrow shot to the centre. When the judge is unable to make the call, an extra arrow can be shot to decide the result of the tie. There will not be second (2nd) opinions called by another judge.

Finals

The finals will take place when all qualifications and the high stakes round have been completed. Top 8 archers, or all archers with 900 scores will advance to the finals.

The finals will commence after one (1) practice end with 1 arrow.

Recurve

- End 1: X10 – 10 – 10 (yellow), 8 – 7 (red), 6 (blue)
- Subsequent ends: X10 – 10 – 9 (yellow), 8 – 7 (red), 6 (blue)

Compound

- End 1: X10 – 10 – 9 (yellow), 8 – 7 (red), 6 (blue)
- Subsequent ends: 10 – 9 – 9 (yellow), 8 – 7 (red), 6 (blue)

Scoring Format

Finals

Barebow:

- End 1: X10 – 10 – 10 (yellow), 8 – 7 (red), 6 – 5 (blue), 4 – 3 (black), 2 – 1 (white), 0 (out of the outermost ring)
- Subsequent ends: X10 – 10 – 10 (yellow), 8 – 7 (red), 6 – 5 (blue), 4 – 3 (black), 2 – 1 (white), 0 (out of the outermost ring)

Ties and shoot offs (only applicable to finals)

In the event of a tie for the first place, archers tied will be required to shoot 3-arrow ends until the tie is broken.

In the event of a tie for a place on the podium, one (1) arrow closest to the centre will be shot and be the result of the tie. For recurve and compound open, any spot of the target face can be shot. A judge will make the final call on the closest arrow to the centre. If the call cannot be decided, the judge will have the full authority to require archers involved to shoot another arrow. No 2nd opinions will be sought from other judges.

For ties that are not shot, ties will be broken based on the qualifications after 3 rounds.

Scoring Format

High stakes round

Only archers ranked from 9th onwards will be able to participate in the high stakes round and earn their spot in the final shoot off. Archers will be competing against the top 50 archers (that did not qualify for the finals) in their respective categories and gender.

Target assignment for the high stakes round will be published on Saturday after the first 60 arrows have been shot, and will consist of the top 50 archers, as well as the archers tied for 50th position per category and gender.

NO high stakes rounds will be available, should any category and gender did not meet the minimum requirement of 32 archers.

The high stakes round will proceed as follows:

- There will be one (1) practice end;
- Archers are to shoot only one (1) arrow;
- It will be shot in 2 shooting lines: AB-CD with a 30 – seconds timer;
- First arrow will be shot as regular scoring mode
 - Recurve: X-X-10-8-7-6
 - Compound: X-10-10-8-7-6
 - Barebow: X-X-10-8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1-0
- Archers tied for maximum score (i.e. X/10) will proceed to the next end
- Second arrow will be shot with the following scoring mode:
 - Recurve: X-10-9-8-7-6
 - Compound: X-9-9-8-7-6
 - Barebow: X-10-9-8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1-0
- Archers tied for the maximum score (i.e X for compound, X/10 for recurve and barebow), will proceed to the next end
- Subsequent arrow(s) will be shot with the following scoring mode:
 - Archers from ALL categories are required to shoot inside out X (arrow needs to be in the X-ring WITHOUT touching lines)
- Remaining archers will move their targets to the centre so they are shooting next to each other
- The judge will guide the archers to the right target
- Closest to the centre scoring will apply for the last arrow;
- The last archer with the closest to centre arrow will advance to the finals

Penalties for breaking of rules

Shooting more than 3 arrows

The score of the 3 lowest scoring arrows will be scored.

Shooting the wrong target

The arrow will be marked as a miss. It is not allowed to shoot more than 3 arrows per end.

Shooting out of time

The highest score on the target will be marked as a miss. The archer will only have scores of the 2 lowest scoring arrows.

Disqualification

If for any reason a dispute occurs, rowdy and rude behaviour is displayed, and/or when safety is at risk, the LOC reserves all and full rights to disqualify the participant and/ or coach.
