E. TECHNICAL ASPECTS OF THE COMPETITION

1. QUALIFICATION ROUNDS – 2 round of 36 arrows (72 arrows). 180 secs per end of 6 arrows.
 - 1.1. Barebow Women
 - 1.2. Barebow Men
 - 1.3. 3 ends official practice prior to qualification round on the Field of Play.
Immediate follow scoring once the field is reset.
 - 1.4. Shooting qualification round will be organized in ABCD format.
2. ELIMINATION ROUNDS
 - 2.1. Individual Elimination: 1/32 (one thirty-two) for Barebow category and 1/16 (one sixteenth) for Barebow Master, man and woman respectively.
Set system – 3 arrows per set – 6 set points.
90 secs per end of 3 arrows.

1/32, 1/16, & 1/8 = 2 archers per target, 1/4, 1/2 & Bronze Medal Matches = 1 archer per target, for Barebow Category.

1/16, 1/8, 1/4 = 2 archers per target, 1/2 & Bronze Medal Mathes = 1 archers per target, for Barebow Master Category.

Gold Medal (Final) Matches – Alternate Shooting (20 secs per arrow).

- 2.2. Mixed Team Elimination: 1/32 (one thirty-two).

Set system – 4 arrows per set – 5 set points.

80 secs per end of 4 arrows.

1/32, 1/16, 1/8, 1/4, 1/2, and Bronze Medal Matches – shoot at the same time.

Gold Medal (Final) Matches – Alternate Shooting.

- 2.3. Team Elimination: 1/16 (one sixteenth) for barebow men and women team respectively.

Set system – 6 arrows per set – 5 set points.

120 secs per end of 6 arrows.

1/16, 1/8, 1/4, 1/2, and Bronze Medal Matches – shoot at the same time.

Gold Medal (Final) Matches – Alternate Shooting.

- 2.4. All Gold Medal Matches – Alternate shooting. Team / club must have an agent when gold medal match.

2.4.1. Venue for medal matches will have practice field and warm-up field.

2.4.2. Will have 6 targets, the same direction as the Field of Play.

2.4.3. Each competing athlete or team can practice 20 minutes prior to their match.

2.4.4. Athletes are not permitted to use scope on the medal match FOP.

3. Equipment Inspection

- 3.1. 20th November 2025 during practice. From 09.00 hrs till 15.00 hrs.
- 3.2. Spare equipment must also be brought for inspections.
- 3.3. Officials and athletes are to check the details of their athletes such as name, team, ID numbers are correct.
- 3.4. Inform the Judge if details are not correct and the Judge will inform Results Team.
- 3.5. Athletes numbers and other facilities will be distributed during practice day.
- 3.6. Athletes numbers must be displayed on the quiver or thigh, facing the waiting line while shooting.

F. PARTICIPANT

- F.1. Open for individuals, archery clubs, associations, and community from Indonesia and international.
- F.2. Each Team consists of maximum 3 men and 3 women.
- F.3. Team Name must be clear and different to the other team names although from same club or country.
- F.4. Number of officials based on inquiry.
- F.5. All athletes and officials participating in this tournament will be issued with only one accreditation card (ID Card).
- F.6. Accreditation card (ID Card) must be worn at all times in the practice and competition areas. No entry without ID Card.

G. RULES

- G.1. The current World Archery Rules will be the guidelines to this championship.
- G.2. Athletes and officials are assumed to understand the rules of the competition.

H. DRESS REGULATION

- H.1. Athletes, officials, and staff should wear full Team uniform. Uniform shirt and shorts/pants/skirts must be of the same color for the members of the same team/club for Team Rounds and Medal Matches. Denim material is prohibited.
- H.2. Clothing and equipment shall not be camouflage.
- H.3. Sport shoes or walking boots shall be worn by all athletes and officials, these may be different styles but shall cover the entire foot.
- H.4. Hand sleeves must be in the same color in one team.
- H.5. Hand sleeves for Gold Medal (Final) Match must be in the same color of uniform dominant color OR white.

I. TEAM AND MIXED-TEAM FORMAT

- I.1. Top 3 archers of each team/club in the qualification round will be ranked together as one team for team match.
- I.2. Number of mixed-team registered per team/club can be more than one mixed-team. In the case more than one mixed-team registered from one team/club, name of the archers must be mentioned on the mixed-team registration form respectively. Name of mixed-team should be added with code such as 1,2,3, etc. or A,B,C etc.

This is an exception i.e. Local Rule from the organizing committee, Not WA Rules.

J. AWARD, MEDALS, AND PRIZES

- J.1. Winners Certificate for individual qualification and all elimination champions.
- J.3. Medal will be awarded to rank :
 - J.3.1. Individual Qualification (rank 1-3).
 - J.3.2. Individual Elimination (1-4)
 - J.3.3. Mixed-Team Elimination (1-4), and
 - J.3.4. Team Elimination (1-4).
- J.4. Total prizes for this tournament is USD 12,550 (twelve thousands five hundred and fifty US Dollars) for the Qualification and Elimination Champions (Final Medal Matches).

- K.1. Registration Fee for each athlete and official respectively: 355,000 Rupiah.
